

## Furniture Shop Risk Assessment Checklist

- Clear pathways to avoid tripping hazards.
- Secure anchoring of heavy or tall furniture items.
- Fire safety measures, including fire-resistant materials.
- Adequate lighting in all areas.
- Safe storage areas for chemicals and cleaning supplies.
- Clearly marked and accessible emergency exits.
- CCTV coverage for security.
- Transparent return and exchange policy.
- Clear product information tags.
- Regular staff training on safety and product knowledge.
- Prompt spill management and cleaning.
- Clear assembly instructions for self-assembly items.
- Anti-theft measures in place.
- Frequent health and safety inspections.
- Secure payment methods and data protection.
- Maintain high standards of hygiene and cleanliness.
- Online catalogue and product information.
- Adequate ventilation throughout the store.
- Accessible and updated First Aid kit.
- Clear signage for all sections, offers, and promotions.
- Effective customer service and assistance.
- Regular checks to ensure product quality and integrity.
- Safe and timely delivery services.
- Clear warranty and guarantee details for products.
- Safe and organized back storage areas.
- Stable and secure product display structures.
- Consideration for staff welfare and breaks.
- Price transparency and no hidden fees.
- System for collecting and reviewing customer feedback.
