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Sportswear Shop Risk Assessment Checklist

- \square Properly displayed sportswear avoiding trip hazards.
- □ Regular quality checks on all products.
- □ Clear and correct pricing on all items.
- □ Safe and clean fitting rooms.
- □ Non-slip flooring throughout the shop.
- □ Accessible fire extinguishers and alarms.
- Staff training on product knowledge and customer service.
- □ Secure storage for high-value items.
- Routine shop cleaning to maintain hygiene.
- □ Clearly marked emergency exits.
- □ CCTV monitoring for security.
- □ Clear returns and exchange policy.
- □ First aid kit available and accessible.
- Stable product displays that don't pose a risk of toppling over.
- □ Regular stock rotation to ensure freshness and quality.
- □ All products have clear and correct labels and size info.
- □ Staff wear identifiable uniforms for easy recognition.
- \square Proper ventilation in the shop, especially during summer months.
- Hygienic changing rooms with regular cleaning.
- □ Appropriate lighting in all areas of the shop.
- Multiple secure payment options for customers.
- □ System for collecting and acting on customer feedback.
- \Box Fitting rooms have safety features (e.g., no sharp edges).
- \square Shop layout is accessible for individuals with disabilities.
- □ Safe areas designated for trying out sportswear or equipment.
- □ Rest areas for staff and seating for customers available.
- \Box Price tags are securely attached to prevent choking hazards.
